Task Engineering Management will ensure resources are provided to implement the Integrated Management System. Task Engineering will strive to improve Occupational Health and Safety performance through regular reviews of objectives and targets to ensure continual improvement.

The Managing Director and General Manager are committed to providing and maintaining a working environment that is safe and without risk to health. To carry this out, both the MD and GM will:

- ✓ Have an OH&S management system based on the requirements of the most current version of AS/NZS 4801.
- ✓ Make sure that that TASK OHS policy and procedures are effectively implemented.
- ✓ Make sure OHS duties are identified and assigned to the appropriate employees
- ✓ Make sure that regular discussion on OHS takes place
- ✓ Provide Safe Plant, machinery and systems of work
- ✓ Provide Protective Equipment as appropriate
- ✓ Provide information, training and supervision
- ✓ Investigate and report on all OHS incidents and accidents so that improvements, where applicable can be made in TASK OHS system
- ✓ Monitor current OHS performance and try to achieve a steadily improving standard of OHS performance.

All TASK Engineering Pty Ltd's employees and subcontractors are required to comply with the Occupational health and Safety plan of the company, and shall

- ✓ Adhere to safe work practices, instructions and rules
- ✓ Perform all duties in a manner which ensures the individual's health and safety, and that of others
- ✓ Co-operate with management to enable health and safety responsibilities to be fulfilled.
